ATTENTION ALL MEMBERS - YOUR VOTE IS NEEDED!

As you all know, the District Governors Niagara Frontier Lion [DGNFL] is currently mailed monthly to each member. PDG Lion Tom Reinagel and the Long Range Planning Committee have brought to our attention the increasing costs involved in mailing the newsletter. Two options are under consideration, both of which are outlined in the separate attachment (this page-on left) in this newsletter. I urge you to read them carefully and consider the impact on our club of both options:

OPTION #1 Continuing to mail the DGNFL to each member will result in a \$7.00 increase per member to our Club.

OPTION #2 Sending the DGNFL electronically will result in an approximate increase of \$3.50 per member to our Club. While this is an apparent saving, this will result in extra postage and printing costs for our Club, for those members who do not receive their newsletters electronically. In addition, our club would be responsible for coordinating the printing and mailing of these additional copies each month. The overall savings to our Club by choosing the electronic method will be marginal after the extra costs incurred are considered. [Editors note: savings for this plan for our club would be approximately \$170 per year while printing and postage costs for 12 members who get the newsletter mailed would be approximately \$128 annually.]

With that in mind, YOUR INDIVIDUAL VOTE IS IMPORTANT! It will be considered by the District 20-N Cabinet before a final vote and decision is made at the March 28th Cabinet Meeting. A vote will be taken at our January 28th meeting. For those who cannot attend, please respond before January 28th to either:
