THE GRAND ISLAND LIONS CLUB SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

This is a community service scholarship that is weighed heavily toward community service and volunteerism. The Grand Island Lions Club will award up to \$2,000 in scholarships to qualifying members of the graduating class of 2024 who are residents of Grand Island. There will be a minimum of two and a maximum of four scholarships awarded with the \$2,000 scholarship award monies.

The scholarships are awarded based on the scholarship applications, as judged by the Grand Island Lions Club scholarship committee. Applicants may attend Grand Island High School or an off-Island High School, but in either case the student must reside on Grand Island. The applications can be found on our website at gilions.com or through a google classroom invite..

These scholarships will be awarded to college-bound students who have made considerable contributions to other people through their involvement in community or faith-based organizations or activities. The Lions Club is looking for students who have completed unique and outstanding community service beyond what is required by school course work, school clubs or youth organizations. Students must have demonstrated that they are preparing themselves to be well-rounded individuals. They must be ready not only for their continued higher education challenges but ready to be productive active citizens who are willing to continue to involve themselves in community institutions and affairs.

Failure to comply with any of the requirements on the scholarship application may disqualify the applicant.

APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES:

- 1. The candidate must submit the following:
 - a. The Grand Island Lions Club Scholarship Google Form.
 - b. Volunteer Participation: In your own words, provide a brief description of your volunteer participation in community or faith-based service organizations. Include the specific organizations and activities you were involved with and the number of hours of service you contributed. Do not include volunteer work that is required by school/course work. Please note: The Grand Island Lions Club reserves the right to verify at any time the validity of your volunteer activities and hours of service.
 - c. **Two letters of recommendation**: Specific Recommender guidelines are posted on the GI Lions Google Form. Provide your recommender with GI Lions Cover Sheet and have them submit the <u>GI Lions cover sheet</u> and letter to: scholarship@gicsd.org, prior to the scholarship deadline.
- 2. All materials must be submitted via the GI Lions Club Google Form by March 25, 2024.

Winners will receive payment of this award following receipt of official registration notification from the recipient's collegiate institution.
