Saturday, September 18, 2021 the Western New York Riding Lions will be hosting its very first fundraiser for Mercy Flight of Western New York. "Bikers Unite for Mercy Flight - Dice Run and Car Cruise" is a State Police escorted dice run beginning at the Mercy Flight-Buffalo headquarters, located at 100 Amherst Villa Road, Buffalo, NY 14225. Registration will begin at 9:00am. Kick stands up at approximately 11:45am. We will be escorted up to the Ft. Niagara State Park for a dice roll, then continue on to the Wheatfield American Legion on Ward Road.
